## What is the Health Ministry?

Health Ministry Nursing is a specialized practice in which a nurse functions as a member of the Pastoral Ministry Team. A Health Ministry nurse integrates faith and health, keeping spirituality central to health and wholeness. These nurses do not provide home health care services or perform invasive nursing procedures. Instead, we provide many caring services that minister to the needs of the congregation.

## What we do...

- Assess health-care needs
- Refer individuals to appropriate community resources
- Serve as resource person for health-related information
- Answer questions about health, medications, procedures, surgery
- Provide health screening, blood pressure, health education
- Listen, comfort and guide those facing health-related challenges
- Act as a liaison between healthcare providers and patients
- Advocate whole person health (mind-body-spirit)

The Health Ministry Team may be reached by contacting one of the nurses directly, through the church office, through a Congregational Support Team member, or through one of the pastors. All contact with the Health Ministry Team is strictly confidential and we adhere to all HIPPA laws.
